In response to a question raised by Councillor T Landsberg, please note the following additional information for your consideration.

#### Question:

Provide details on where the grant money that is not expended on Bowman Road and Gosling Street intersection will go.

### Response:

The Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program Phase 4 (LRCIP4) Grant funding program guidelines state that eligible projects are required to be physically completed by 30 June 2025.

While the Bowman Road/Gosling Street Intersection Upgrade meets eligibility criteria it will not be physically complete by this date.

To ensure all LRCIP4 funding is able to be acquitted by this deadline, \$1,757,575 has been reallocated from the Bowman Road/Gosling Street Intersection Upgrade to two projects:

Kiamba Road Bridge Replacement \$ 557,575 Commissioners Flat Road Safety Improvements \$1,200,000

Both projects meet eligibility criteria and the required funding acquittal deadline and have been accepted by the Commonwealth Government.

In response to a question raised by Councillor T Burns, please note the following additional information for your consideration.

#### Question:

Can you please provide additional information regarding the constructability issues being faced by UnityWater?

### Response:

UnityWater, as part of their application for the additional easement area, provided the following justification:-

During the drilling operation, the contractor experienced a hole collapse within the soft geology. Due to this collapse, a partial redrill is required to avoid the collapsed area while staying parallel to the existing alignment.

Key mitigation measures to prevent recurrence include:

- Installation of a steel casing through the soft geology.
- Planning the construction methodology for drilling to operate 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, which provides improved hole stability due to continuous operation.'
