Please confirm the jurisdiction for regulating responsible dog management on Goat Island.

Response:

The prohibition of dogs on Goat Island can be managed by Council Officers under the Local Law. As the area is tidal, and the location of sand changes in the area, and therefore the map is considered indicative and the law applies to where the land is at any given time.

The *Animal Management (Cats and Dogs) Act 2008* is State legislation which allows Council to manage the effective control of dogs in other areas.

The Smart Cities team has reviewed the development application for the proposed Telecommunications Tower and advises that there are no comments or recommendations to provide at this time.
